Aria Mittens

This is one of the projects I'm really proud of, super simple and easy but looks soo cute and refined. Aria mittens came up from doing my favourite stitch, plus adding a slip stitch to give it a bit nicer texture. If you are a crocheter who likes the look of a knit stitch don't look further, because this pattern is just for you!

So let's start...



Material we'll be using:

Worsted weight yarn (4)

Crochet hooks 6mm (toddler size)
and 4.5 mm

Scissors

Tapestry needle

Stitch markers(optional)

Stitches you'll need to know

Chain

Slip stitch

Yarn over slip stitch

Abbreviations we'll be using

CH - chain

SS - slip stitch

YO SS - yarn over slip stitch

H-crochet hook

BLO - back loop only

T-CH - turning chain

Toddler size

Left mitten

CH 31 H# 6 mm

Row 1: SS 3 H#4, YO SS 12 H#6, YO SS 15 H#4

T-CH

Row 2: SS BLO 15 H#4, YO SS BLO 12 H#6, SS

BLO 3 H#4

T-CH

Row 3: SS BLO 3 H#4, YO SS BLO 12 H#6, YO

SS BLO 15 H#4

T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 11 rows.



Now we'll just work with hook size
4 mm

Row 12: SS BLO 30
T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 13,
CH 8, turn your work and slip
stitch in the back of your chain 7,
start working in the same stitch SS
until the end,
17 stitches in total.

T-CH



Row 15: SS BLO 13 YO SS BLO 15
SS BLO 17

CH 1, turn your work

Row 16: SS BLO 45

CH 1 turn

Row 17: SS BLO 13 YO SS BLO 15
SS BLO 17

CH 1, turn your work





Row 18: SS BLO 24,
SS 7 working your hook
through the back loop of
your next stitch as well as
back loop of the opposite,
connecting the two sides
together

Then continue SS BLO 13
more stitches

CH 1 turn



Row 19: SS BLO 30, T-CH.



Row 20: SS BLO 30, T-CH

Row 21: SS BLO 30, T-CH

Repeat this until Row 29



CH 1,

Take your hook out and flip your work right side facing you, then put your hook through the first loop in the foundation chain and start connecting with a slip stitch, through every loop on the foundation chain and the back loop of you last row.

Cut your yarn leaving 10 cm to see on top part. Pull the yarn a bit to make it more narrow on the top.

Right mitten

This mitten we'll start from the opposite side using 4mm hook only

CH 31

Row 1: 30 SS, T-CH

Row 2: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Repeat this until you have total amount of 11 rows

Row 12: SS BLO 17, CH 8, turn your work and slip stitch in the back of your chain 7, start working in the same stitch SS 11 until the end

T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 13 YO SS BLO 15 SS BLO 17, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 45, T-CH

Row 15: SS BLO 13 YO SS BLO 15 SS BLO 17, T-CH

Row 16: SS BLO 21, SS 7 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as back loop of the opposite, connecting the two sides together

Then continue SS BLO 17 more stitches

Row 17: 30 SS BLO

T-CH

Row 18: 30 SS BLO

T-CH

Row 19: SS 3 H#4, YO SS 12 H#6, YO SS 15 H#4

T-CH

Row 20: SS BLO 15 H#4, YO SS BLO 12 H#6, SS BLO 3 H#4

T-CH

Row 21: SS BLO 3 H#4, YO SS BLO 12 H#6, YO SS BLO 15 H#4

T-CH

Repeat this pattern until you have the total amount of 29 rows.

12-18 months

Left mitten

CH 31 H# 4 mm

Row 1: SS 3, YO SS 27, T-CH

Row 2: SS BLO 15, YO SS BLO 12, SS BLO 3 , T-CH

Row 3: SS BLO 3, YO SS BLO 27, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 11 rows.

Row 12: SS BLO 30 , T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 30, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 17, CH 8, turn your work and slip stitch in the back of your chain 7, start working in the next stitch SS until the end, 17 stitches in total, T-CH

Row 15: SS BLO 13, YO SS BLO 15, SS BLO 17, T-CH

Row 16: SS BLO 45, T-CH

Row 17: SS BLO 13, YO SS BLO 15, SS BLO 17 T-CH

Row 18: SS BLO 24, SS 7 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as front loop of the opposite, connecting the two sides together . Then continue SS BLO 13 more stitches

T-CH

Row 19: SS BLO 30, T-CH

Row 20: SS BLO 30 , T-CH

Row 21: SS BLO 30, T-CH

Repeat this until Row 29

CH 1

take your hook out and flip your work right side facing you,
then put your hook through the first loop in the foundation chain and start connecting with
a slip stitch, through every loop on the foundation chain and the back loop of you last row.

Cut your yarn leaving 10 cm to see on top part.

Pull the yarn a bit to make it more narrow on the top,
sew it in a zig zag motion and weave in the loose ends

Right mitten

This mitten we'll start from the opposite side, then we did with the left one.

CH 31

Row 1: 30 SS, T-CH

Row 2: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Row 3: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Repeat this until you have total amount of 11 rows

Row 12: SS BLO 17, CH 8, turn your work and slip stitch in the back of your chain 7, start working in the next stitch SS until the end, 13 stitches, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 13, YO SS 15, SS BLO 17, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 45, T-CH

Row 15: SS BLO 13, YO SS BLO 15, SS BLO 17, T-CH

Row 16: SS BLO 25, SS 7 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as front loop of the opposite, connecting the two sides together

Then continue SS BLO 17 more stitches , T-CH

Row 17: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Row 18: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Row 19: SS 3, YO SS 27, T-CH

Row 20: SS BLO 15, YO SS BLO 12, SS BLO 3 , T-CH

Row 21: SS BLO 3, YO SS BLO 27, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating rows 20 and 21 until you have the total amount of 29 rows.

Row 16: SS BLO 25, SS 7 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as front loop of the opposite, connecting the two sides together

Then continue SS BLO 17 more stitches , T-CH

Row 17: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Row 18: 30 SS BLO, T-CH

Row 19: SS 3, YO SS 27, T-CH

Row 20: SS BLO 15, YO SS BLO 12, SS BLO 3 , T-CH

Row 21: SS BLO 3, YO SS BLO 27, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating rows 20 and 21 until you have the total amount of 29 rows.

6-12 months

Left mitten

CH 27

Row 1: SS 3, YO SS 23, T-CH

Row 2: SS BLO 13, YO SS BLO 10, SS BLO 3, T-CH

Row 3: SS BLO 3, YO SS BLO 23, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 9 rows.

Row 10: SS BLO 26, T-CH

Row 11: SS BLO 10, CH 6, turn your work and slip stitch in the back of your chain 5 , start working in the next stitch SS until the end, 16 stitches in total, T-CH

Row 12: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 15: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 16: SS BLO 22, SS 5 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as front loop of the opposite, connecting the two sides together

Then continue SS BLO 10 more stitches, T-CH

Row 17: SS BLO 26, T-CH

Row 18: SS BLO 26, T-CH

Row 19: SS BLO 26, T-CH

Repeat this until Row 25

CH 1, take your hook out and flip your work right side facing you, then put your hook through the first loop in the foundation chain and start connecting with a slip stitch, through every loop on the foundation chain and the back loop of you last row. Cut your yarn leaving 10 cm to see on top part. Pull the yarn a bit to make it more narrow on the top.

Right mitten

This mitten we'll start from the opposite side

CH 27

Row 1: 26 SS, T-CH

Row 2: 26 SS BLO, T-CH

Repeat this until you have total amount of 9 rows

Row 10: SS BLO 16, CH 6, turn your work and slip stitch in the back of your chain 5 ,
start working in the next stitch SS until the end, 10 stitches in total, T-CH

Row 11: SS BLO 10, YO SS BLO 11, SS BLO 16, T-CH

Row 12: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 36, T-CH

Row 15: SS BLO 16, SS 5 working your hook through the back loop of your next stitch as well as front loop of
the opposite, connecting the two sides together

Then continue SS BLO 15 more stitches, T-CH

Row 16: SS BLO 26, T-CH

Row 17: SS 3, YO SS 23, T-CH

Row 18: SS BLO 13, YO SS BLO 10, SS BLO 3 , T-CH

Row 19: SS BLO 3, YO SS BLO 23, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 25 rows.

3-6 months

CH 25

Row 1: SS 2, YO SS 22 ,T-CH

Row 2: SS BLO 12, YO SS BLO 12, T-CH

Row 3: SS BLO 2, YO SS BLO 22, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 11 rows.

Row 12: SS BLO 24, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 2, YO SS BLO 10, SS BLO 12, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 24, T-CH

Repeat until Row 23, T-CH

Take your hook out and flip your work right side facing you, then put your hook through the first loop in the foundation chain

and start connecting with a slip stitch, through every loop on the foundation chain and the back loop of you last row, 20 stitches total.

Cut your yarn leaving 10 cm to see on top part.

Pull the yarn a bit to make it more narrow on the top and sew it in in a zig zag motion.

Weave in the loose ends.

For the other mitten repeat the pattern

0-3 months

CH 21 H#4.5

Row 1: SS 2, YO SS 18, T-CH

Row 2: SS BLO 10, YO SS BLO 10, T-CH

Row 3: SS BLO 2, YO SS BLO 18, T-CH

Repeat this pattern alternating 2nd and 3rd row until you have the total amount of 11 rows.

Row 12: SS BLO 20, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 2, YO SS BLO 8, SS BLO 10, T-CH

Row 14: SS BLO 20, T-CH

Row 13: SS BLO 2, YO SS BLO 8, SS BLO 10, T-CH

Repeat this alternating between the two rows until Row 23

Take your hook out and flip your work right side facing you, then put your hook through the first loop in the foundation chain and start connecting with a slip stitch, through every loop on the foundation chain and the back loop of you last row, 20 stitches total

Cut your yarn leaving 10 cm to sew on top part.

Pull the yarn a bit to make it more narrow on the top and sew it in in a zig zag motion. Weave in the loose ends

For the other mitten repeat the pattern
